Marriage Minute ~

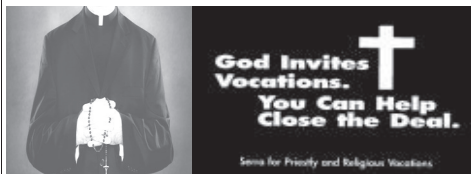
