these priests and our youth by attending this game.

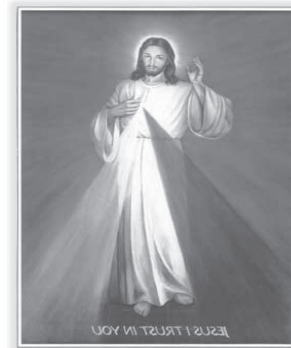
