## Weekly Schedule

(June 22 to June 29)

<p><b>Corpus Christi, Sunday, June 22, 2014</b></p> <p><b>The cup we share, is it not the blood of Christ? And the bread we share, is it not his body? Just as God fed the Israelites with manna from heaven, so too do we feed on the best of wheat, the bread of angels, food for the pilgrim journey.</b></p> <p><i>An annual procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi, or on a day near the feast, is appropriate.</i></p> <p>When did Jesus institute the Holy Eucharist? When did he offer the first Mass? He did it on Holy Thursday. What did he do first? He, the Lord and Master of the Universe, knelt down to wash the feet of his disciples. He, as Lord and Master of the Universe, gave them an example of service.</p> <p>What are the conditions for receiving Holy Communion worthily? The first requirement is fasting from food and nourishing drink for an hour before communion. The second is freedom from serious sin. The third is a right intention, receiving Holy Communion not just because everyone else is doing it, but because of wanting what God wants in our lives.</p> <p>Many years ago in England, Msgr. Ronald Knox talked about ways in which a mirror reminds us of the Eucharist. If you look into a mirror, who do you see? You see yourself, of course. Suppose you have the misfortune to drop the mirror and it breaks into many pieces? Each small piece of mirror will have your image on it.</p> <p>If the priest at Mass fails to consecrate enough hosts, what does he do? He simply breaks each consecrated host into two or more smaller parts. Each part contains body, blood, soul and divinity of Christ. It is amazing!</p> <p>What is your favorite food? Pizza, a rib eye, ice cream, chocolate candy, sushi, a pistachio nut? When we eat, our body in almost miraculous manner transforms the food and drink we consume into our very own flesh and blood. It's a miracle!</p> <p><b>Fr. Gerard Senecal, O.S.B., Pastor, IC &amp; SS Churches</b></p> <p>But if we think for a moment that when we eat of the body of Christ and drink of his blood that we transform God into ourselves, that would be a sacrilege. Rather, as St. Paul says when we eat of the flesh of the Son of Man and drink of his blood, it is we who are transformed into the very life of God.
