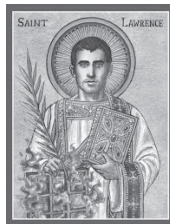
The K of C will be making fresh pizzas (thin crust) this year on Sat. Aug. 26th. We will be taking orders after Masses and appreciate your patronage.

Marriage Minute ~

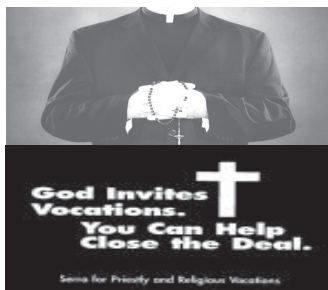
