BAPTISMS You must be registered in one of the above parishes or have the permission of the pastor where you live. Required preparation classes are held monthly for both parents and godparents. MARRIAGE You must contact the pastor **at least six full months** prior to the desired date of marriage and before making any other arrangements. Please contact the church office for a copy of the up-dated wedding policy or view online at www.marytownyouth.com.

Registering In Your Parish

If you are 18 years of age or older, and live in the parishes of Immaculate Conception/Holy Cross or St. Stanislaus, please make sure you register at the appropriate parish office. This will be important if you are asked to be a sponsor for a Confirmation, or a godparent for a Baptism, or if you plan to be married in any of those churches. Most parishes require a letter from your pastor stating that the person is a registered and active parishioner in their home parish. Obviously that is difficult to do, unless the person has registered already. Most parishes also have discounted rates for hall rentals, priority for church use, etc., for those who are their own parishioners... only makes sense.

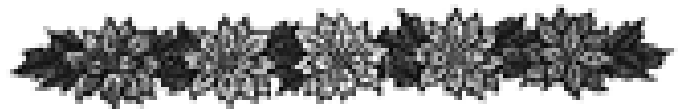

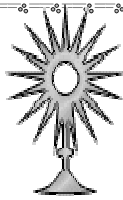
