Rite Of Election and Rite of Sending ~ The RCIA Process

The Rite of Sending and the Rite of Election go hand in hand within the process of the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Unless you live in the Cathedral Parish, the Bishop will come and receive you in the Rite of Election; you will experience the Rite of Sending. These two rites are all about sending you for a reason, receiving you and returning you to the parish in anticipation of Easter Sacraments in a few short weeks. Each rite you celebrate is a passing from one way of understanding the Christian life to another more discerning, zealous approach to the life in Christ you are seeking. In the Rite of Acceptance, remember:

Standing at the church doors and knocking as
The doors were opened wide for you to enter?
You were accepted into the body of Christ,
Being introduced to the new community by
Your sponsor and becoming a part of this
Parish community, as you Embraced the
Word of our Lord, as well as accepting His
Cross. You then promised to walk in the
Light of Christ and inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

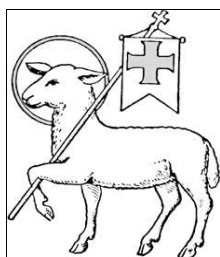
SACRAMENTS

Qui tollis peccata mundi = who takes away the sins of the world

Miserere nobis = have mercy on us.

Dona nobis pacem = give/grant us peace.

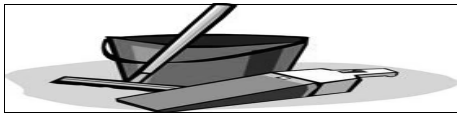

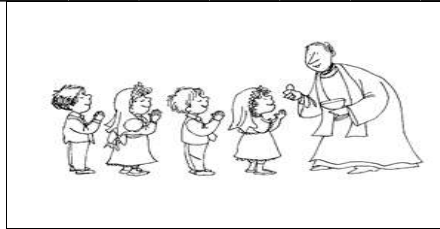

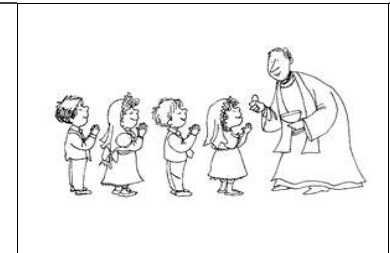

Registering In Your Parish

If you are 18 years of age or older, and live in the parishes of Immaculate Conception/Holy Cross or St. Stanislaus, **please make sure you are registered at the appropriate parish office.** This will be important if you are asked to be a sponsor for a Confirmation, or a godparent for a Baptism, or if you plan to be married in any of those churches. Most parishes require a letter from your pastor stating that the person is a registered and active parishioner in their home parish. Obviously that is difficult to do, unless the person has registered already.
