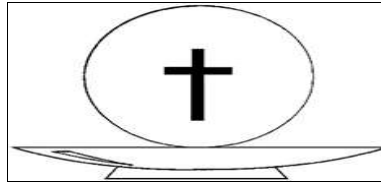

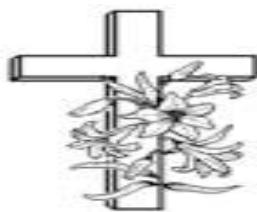
Runnin' Revs Fun Night
