A yard stick offers measure, but taste isn't by the inch. A taste for God, a taste for goodness is fostered in tomato joy!

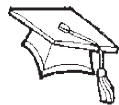
The May Family of the Month selected by K of C Council #657 is the Rick and Diane Budden family. Rick has also been selected as the Knight of the Month. Congratulations!

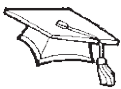
