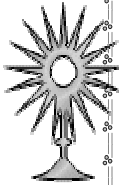

Will be held the 4th Wed. of the month at Sacred Heart Church in Topeka. Dates: June 27, July 25, Aug. 22, Sept. 26, Oct. 24, Nov. 28 and Dec. 26. Confessions are from 6:15 to 7:00pm. During this time the rosary is recited and the Marian messages are read. Mass follows at 7pm. A 10-15 minute talk is given on the subject of life, the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Church, etc. The prayer time concludes with 10 minutes of adoration and benediction.
