There will be a set agenda including: #1) the facts of the history, including the point of closure, #2) the concerns of the present situation are articulated, #3) and the opportunity for concerned parties to speak within a time limit. This is to ensure that we will be able to hear from the largest number of voices within the time frame.

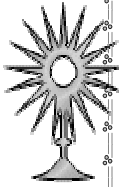
