Sacred Heart oratory, Delia

As the priest with pastoral oversight of the Sacred Heart oratory in Delia, I met with a group of people this last Monday evening, with Fr. John Riley, Chancellor, present as the archbishop's representative.

Due to the present financial status of the oratory, Fr. Riley has communicated to me: *"As a follow up to the meeting, I would like you to communicate to the interested parties who desire to maintain the oratory as-is for the foreseeable future that they need to develop, as I indicated in the meeting, a proposal for a sustainable, long range, self-funded financial and operating/maintenance plan for the oratory and property."*

"Communications or letters soliciting pledges of support should first be approved by you [Fr. Ansems] as pastoral overseer to ensure that the proper messaging is conveyed and that the canonical status of the oratory is properly communicated, and that the financial plan is in fact a proposal on which the Archbishop will at least in part base his decision regarding the future of the oratory."

"The proposed plan that the group develops should be completed and in my office no later than August 15, 2012."

I hope this information will help to provide some clarification as to why certain people/families may be receiving correspondence regarding the oratory in the near future.
