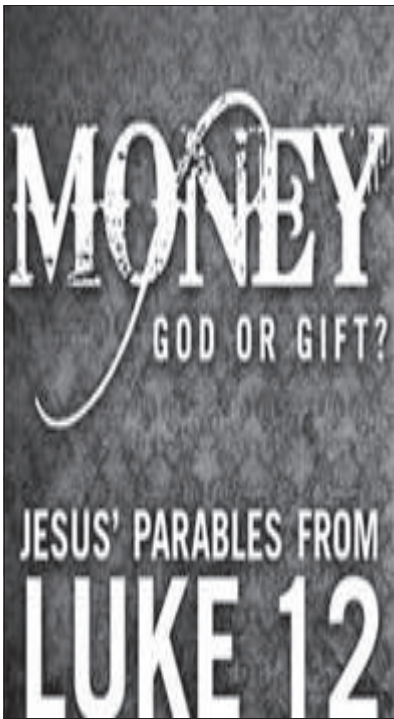

Saying Against Greed and Parable of the Rich Fool

BAPTISMS You must be registered in one of the above parishes or have the permission of the pastor where you live. Required preparation classes are held monthly for both parents and godparents. Perpetual Exposition

The local bishop has responsibility for the regulation of perpetual exposition.

In keeping with The Roman Ritual for the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, four to six candles are lighted. Holy water may also be present as a reminder of our baptism into the death and resurrection of Christ.

Before the Blessed Sacrament exposed we are to contemplate and meditate on the mysteries of the life, passion, death and resurrection of our Savior, especially by making use of readings taken from Sacred Scripture. Praying of the Rosary, which is admirable in its simplicity and even its profundity, is not to be excluded. Periodicals, magazines and other types of public media should not be permitted, as well as food and drink (except water).

The Most Holy Sacrament, when exposed, must never be left unattended even for the briefest span of time. When one enters and leaves the chapel where the Sacrament is exposed, it is customary to make a single genuflection. Silence should be kept.

It is recommended that the Eucharist used for the sole purpose of exposition be consecrated once a month or more frequently if possible.

Adoration of our Blessed Lord in the tabernacle is recommended, and brings many blessings. Perpetual adoration, carried out with lay people assuming the responsibility for organizing a schedule of adorers, day and night, inspires a union with the sacrificial love of Christ that will bring even greater blessings to everyone in the participating parishes.

Parishioners will have the opportunity to hear Fr. Victor Warkulwiz, Blessed Sacrament missionary from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, speak on Perpetual Adoration in October.
