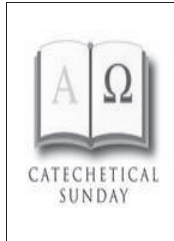

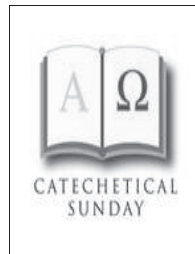

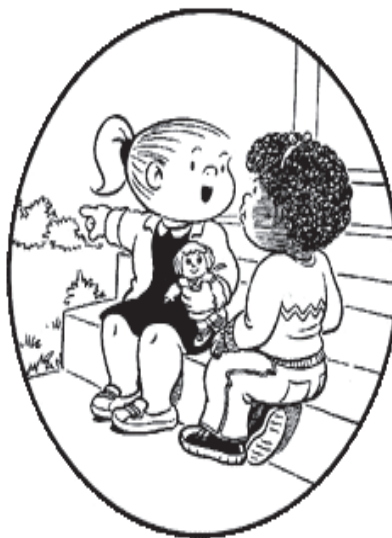
K of C Council #657 Golf Tournament on August 25th at St. Marys Public
