*The ancient teaching of the Church on how gifts of the Holy Spirit work in your life and in the life of your parish community.

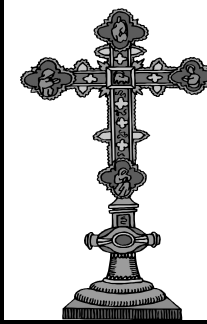
*The five steps of discerning the gifts that God has given you.

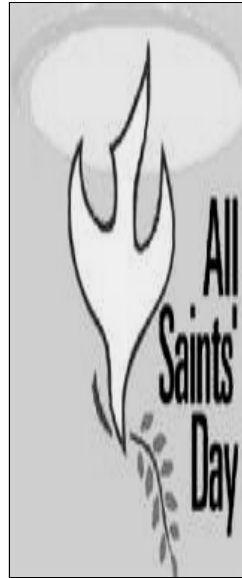

November 1st, All Saints Day, is a Holy Day of Obligation ~

***Vigil Mass ~ Monday, Oct. 31st at 5pm** at St. Stanislaus (Note the earlier time because it is Halloween.)

***Morning Mass will be celebrated at 7am** at Immaculate Conception for those who work by 8am

***Evening Mass at 7pm** at Immaculate Conception. (NOTE ~ There will be the **Confirmation** at this Mass, but this Mass will fulfill your obligation because it will be the Mass for All Saints.)

Registering In Your Parish

If you are 18 years of age or older, and live in the parishes of Immaculate Conception/Holy Cross or St. Stanislaus, please make sure you register at the appropriate parish office. This will be important if you are asked to be a sponsor for a Confirmation, or a godparent for a Baptism. Most parishes require a letter from your pastor stating that the person is a registered and active parishioner in their home parish. Obviously that is difficult to do, unless the person has registered already.
