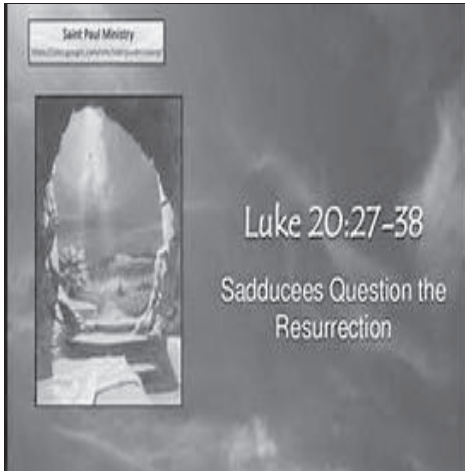

The Question About the Resurrection

Some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, came forward and put this question to Jesus, saying, “Teacher, Moses wrote for us, if someone’s brother dies leaving a wife but no child, his brother must take the wife and raise up descendants for his brother, Now there were seven brothers; the first married a woman but died childless. Then the second and third married her, and likewise all the seven died childless. Finally the woman also died. Now at the resurrection whose wife will that woman be? For all seven had been married to her.” Jesus said to them, “The children of this age marry and remarry; but those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. They can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of

God because they are the ones who will rise. That the dead will rise even Moses made known in the passage about the bush, when he called out ‘Lord,’ the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive.”

Weekly Schedule

(November 10 to November 17)

Marriage cannot be an arrangement "until further notice." The "intimate union of marriage, as a mutual giving of two persons, and the good of the children, demand total fidelity from the spouses and require an unbreakable union between them."

It has been written that when God created woman, He did not take her from the head of a man. God did not wish her to be his master. But also it is important to note that He did not take her from man's feet. He did not wish her to be his servant either. Rather, God took her from man's side so that she might stand along side him as his equal, his support, and friend.

Every marriage is ultimately a mismatch. No one gets all he or she had anticipated out of a marriage. But if the couple are intelligent enough to appreciate this point, then no matter what the storm they will ride out the hurricane.

A good example of this is found in famed British actress Dame Sibyl Thorndike. She and her mate were contentedly married for decades. Following his death, she was asked by the media whether she had ever contemplated divorce. Imperiously she sniffed, "Divorce never! Murder yes!"

A couple was asked, "How does one get a perfect marriage?" Their answer came across loud and clear, "The same way you get to Carnegie Hall - practice, practice, practice!"

One marriage counselor advises that marriages could be much happier events. All the husband and wife need to do is spend as much time and effort in pleasing each other during marriage as they did in courting and winning each other.

When couples run into rough waters in their marriage, they must recall the advice of the late Joseph Cardinal Bernardin of Chicago. Couples need to learn that marriage is the only game in town where two can play and both can win!
