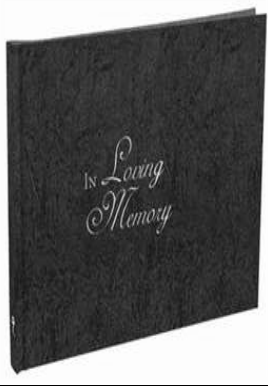

Congratulations to all the Confirmation Students

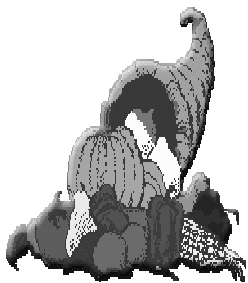
